

REMINDERS WHEN USING AN AEROSMITH CT90 TOOL

1. Check and tighten all screws before using and at least daily during use.
2. Keep the tool well lubricated:
 - a. Put a few drops of lightweight, non-detergent oil in the air inlet of the tool **BEFORE** connecting the tool to the air line for use.
 - b. Put a drop or two of oil in the hole at the center of the slide end plate (#431) when beginning to use the tool and frequently (ever 1-2 hours) during sustained use.
3. Keep the tool clean.
4. Always use 3/8" air hose and fittings.
5. Use **ONLY** clean, dry, regulated compressed air to operate the tool.
6. Do not use more air pressure than required to perform the task. **NEVER** EXCEED THE PRESSURE LIMITS OF THE TOOL.
7. **ALWAYS WEAR SAFETY GLASSES** when operating the tool.
8. **NEVER** engage in horseplay with the tool.
9. Use **ONLY** GENUINE AEROSMITH parts for any tool repair.
